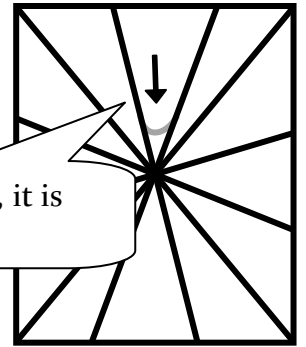
METHOD ONE



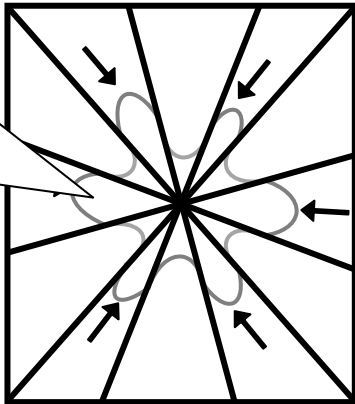
① Use a ruler or straight edge to draw two lines.



② Draw an even number of lines crossing the center.

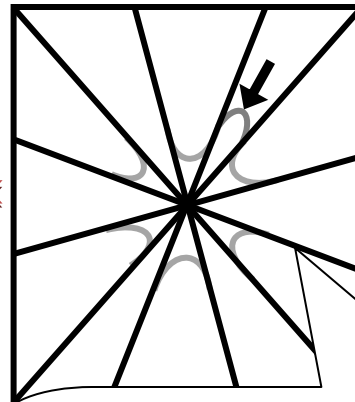


③ Draw a smile, it is an "arc" shape.

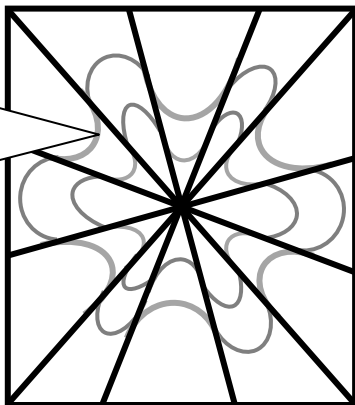


④ Draw the "arc" on every other triangle.

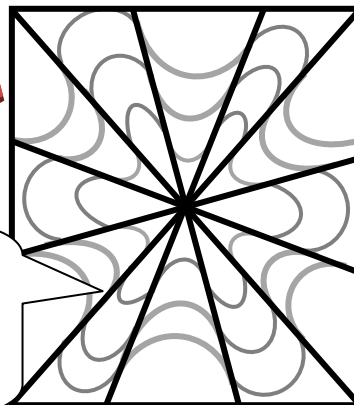
⑥ Draw the frown "arc" in all the empty spaces as shown.



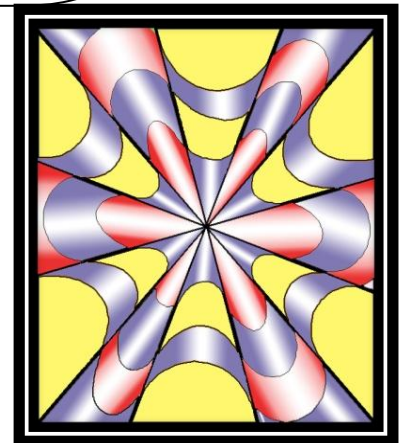
⑤ Draw a frown, it is the opposite "arc" of the smile. Draw it in an empty space. The frown and smile edges must touch.



⑦ After the first rows, add a second row - the same way.



⑧ Wow, finish the lines the same way, make sure they touch; and there you have it!

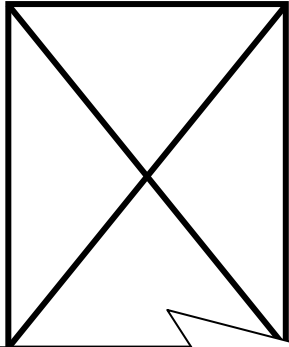
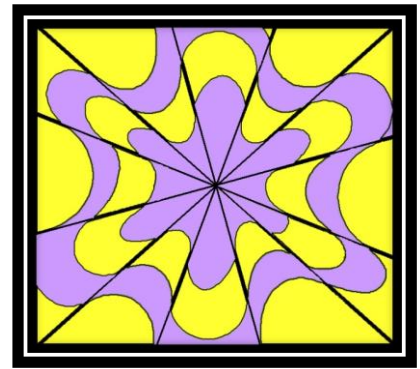

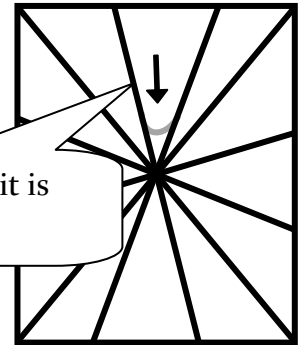
METHOD TWO



① Use a ruler or straight edge to draw two lines.

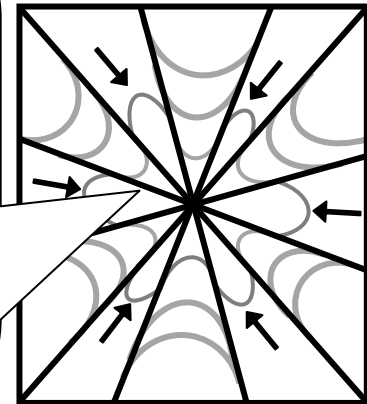


② Draw an even number of lines crossing the center.

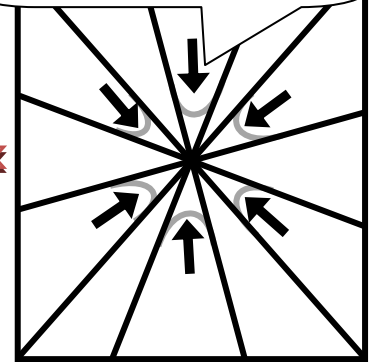


③ Draw a smile, it is an "arc" shape.

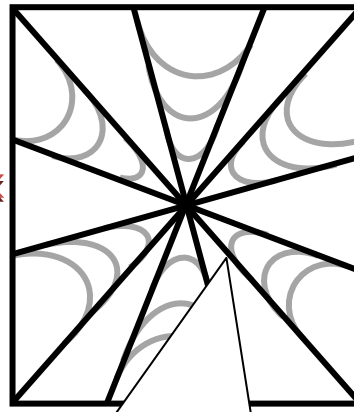
⑥ Draw a frown, it is the opposite "arc" of the smile. Draw them in the empty spaces. The frown and smile edges must touch.



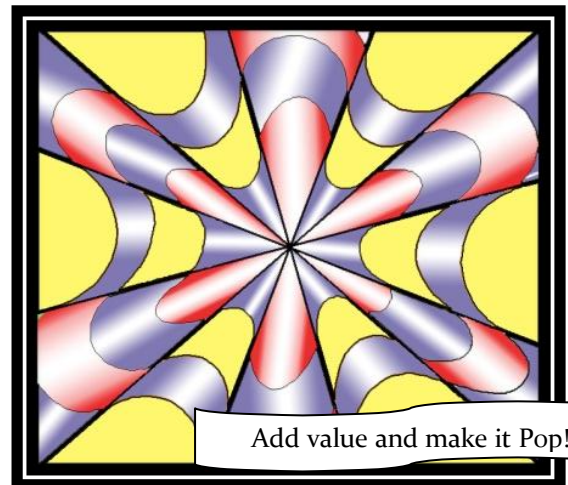
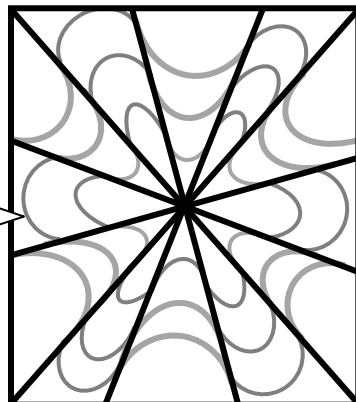
④ Draw the "arc" on every other triangle.
