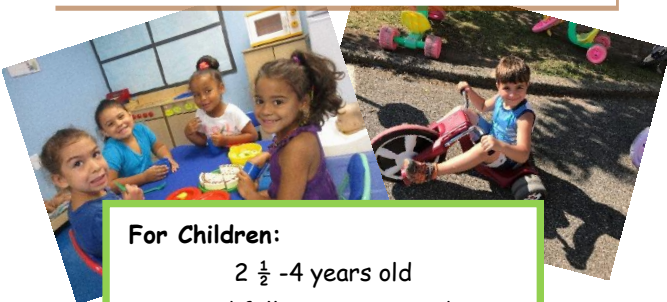

For Children:

2 ½ -4 years old
and fully potty-trained

Daily Schedule (Flexible):

- 7:30-9:00 Arrival & Free Play
- 9:00-9:45 Circle Time
- 9:45-10:00 Snack
- 10:00-11:00 Work Time
- 11:00-12:00 Indoor/Outdoor Play
- 12:00-12:45 Lunch
- 12:45-2:45 Nap/Rest Time
- 2:45-3:15 Wake Up/Snack
- 3:15-4:45 Structured Activities
- 4:45-6:00 Free Center Play



Daily Activities include:

1. Dramatic Play - dress up clothing, play food, etc.
2. Block Center - building with Legos, blocks, etc.
3. Library - exploring books, felt board stories, etc.
4. Science Center - using magnifying glasses, magnets, etc.
5. Arts & Crafts - painting, cutting, gluing, etc.
6. Music - singing songs, playing instruments, etc.
7. Engaging Gross Motor Skills - (using large muscles) running, skipping, jumping, etc.
8. Developing Fine Motor Skills - (using smaller muscle groups) name writing, cutting, etc.
9. Water Play - discovering volume and capacity using buckets, funnels, etc.
10. Technology - learning through use of iPad and SMARTboard interaction

Teacher Qualifications:

- All full time teachers are state certified
- All teachers are CPR and First Aid certified

Tuition:

\$700 a month plus a \$40 yearly membership to the Boys and Girls Club of Clifton

Part Time Options:

- Half Day: Monday-Friday 7:30 AM-12:30PM (\$500)
- 4 Full Days (\$600) / 3 Full Days (\$500)

(Children in our part time program are LOCKED into the selected days. THERE ARE NO MAKE UP DAYS. There is a \$30 fee for any extra days needed.)

For Current 'Campers':

- **Tentative Date**-a \$700 non-refundable deposit is due

For New 'Campers'

- **Tentative Date**- a \$700 non-refundable deposit is due

For Current and New 'Campers'

- **Tentative Date** -Final summer payment due A \$700 non-refundable balance is due. Your child will not be able to attend camp without final payment.

To ensure availability for your child, payments must be received by dates noted! There are no exceptions!

4C's Program:

It is your responsibility to swipe your child in and out every day in the Early Childhood Office, with the card 4C's provides you. Failure to do so will result in a \$5 fee per day. Unfortunately, your child will not be allowed to attend school until payment is received.

Income Eligibility:

For reduced rate fee you must provide us with the following information:

- Completed Gingerbread Application
- Copy of previous year Income Tax Return
- Welfare Pink Slip or Medicare Card

Please note, without this information, we cannot consider your child for reduced rate.





Attendance Procedures:

For everyone's safety, when dropping off, please park in a parking spot. **DO NOT PARK ALONG THE CURB!**

- Once in the building, scan your child's ID and your security key card at the front desk. If you are new to our program, we will provide you with a security key card and your child's ID card as soon as possible.
- All parents need a security key card to enter classrooms. Each security key card requires a deposit of ten dollars. Key cards may be purchased in the Early Childhood office. Every adult dropping off/picking up your child **MUST** have a security key card daily.
- In the classroom, when signing your child in or out, please specify the time. It is a state requirement!
- If your child is absent, please call to inform us. Any student absent more than 5 days due to illness shall not be re-admitted without a doctor's note.

Hours:

Our hours are 7:30am-5:30pm. Pick up after 5:30PM will result in a late fee of \$2.00 per minute.

- We will use our cell phones as the 'official time'.
- In the event you are late, the late fee **MUST** be paid the following day.
- Unfortunately, your child may not attend our center until payment is received.

Extended Care:

Our Hours are 7:30-5:30pm; however, we do offer Extended Care:

Extended Care:

- 5:30-6:00pm \$10.00/weekly

Payments must be received every Monday of the week you wish your child to participate

Send in a change of clothes for your child.

Be sure to label everything.

Snack and Lunch:

We provide 100% fruit juice, water, string cheese, crackers and cereal for snack twice a day.

- Parents must provide lunch in a lunch box, **NO BACKPACKS.**
- We do not heat lunches, please use a thermos for hot items.
- If your child's lunch requires a spoon or fork, please send one in. We do not supply utensils.
- Pizza Mondays! \$3 for one slice. \$5 for two slices. Snack and juice included. Payment must be received by 10AM Monday

Child's Safety:

It would be preferred for your child to wear sneakers or closed toe shoes with straps. For safety reasons, no sandals or flip flops!



Nap Time:

It is not required for your child to sleep, but he or she must rest quietly.

- Send in only a crib size sheet, small blanket, and very small pillow. All bedding must be able to fit flat into our XXL Hefty bags
- Bedding needs to be sent home every Friday according to the State Policy

Toy Policy:

Toys, stuffed animals, hand held electronic games, etc. are only permitted in school on Show & Tell days. Your cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated!
